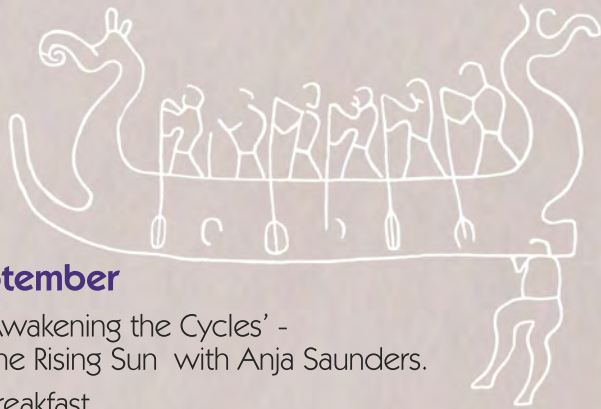

The Venue - Gaunts House

DIRECTIONS

By car from London: M3 and M 27 West. A31 to Wimborne

By car from Bristol: A4 to Bath, A35 to Wimborne

From Wimborne: take the B3078, which runs north from Wimborne toward Cranborne for 3 miles. The entrance to Gaunts House is on the right, adjacent to a thatched 'mushroom' cottage.

By train: depart from London Waterloo or Bristol for Poole.

By bus: take 132 or 133 from Poole to Wimborne and then taxi to Gaunts House.
